Sites: **Museum Mile:** is a lovely stretch along 5th Ave. full of museums and other fine art institutions.

Central Park: Spanning 843 Acres in the heart of Manhattan, Central Park is one of the world's greatest urban oases. Among its attractions are Wollman Rink, Central Park Zoo, Belvedere Castle and Friedsam Memorial Carousel.

Statue of Liberty/ Ellis Island/ 9-11 Memorial Museum: at the World Trade Center. The Pubic can learn about the memorial and museum and view on-going construction. The memorial honors nearly 3000 people who died in the attacks on Feb. 26,1993 and Sept. 11,2001

Time Square: with massive digital billboards whose bright lights make mid-night look like mid afternoon; star studied Broadway shows, visitors can shop in flagship locations , and with Broadway closed to cars from West 42nd to West 47th Streets, Time Square is now more pedestrian friendly than ever.
